(This would give the practice 5 Male GPs and 7 Female GPs) Gully Patel Health Care Assistant is due to start a 2 year course to become a Nursing Associate. Elliott Wright is in his 2 nd year training as an Assistant Practitioner. The practice has started recruiting from existing staff for a Deputy Practice Manager, this is to help AN with the increasing workload and to have succession planning in place. The list size current stands at 13,800 and there has been an increase in the number of female patients. A mini Health Day is taking place on the 9 th Dec promoting vaccinations and BP checks. The next Healthy Darwen event is planned for the 17/18 th May and BT and AP are involved in trying to make this very much a family event.
